**EAGCC December 2011 Meeting Minutes**

**December 13, 2011**

**The meeting was called to order by President Al Mitchell at  
6:30PM with 20 members present.**

**Secretary's Report: Minutes of the last meeting were accepted as  
distributed.**

**Treasurer's Report: Last month we had revenues of \$3,367.00  
against expenses of \$3,670.63 for a net loss for November of  
\$303.63. We had \$2,248.57 in the treasury as of November 30.**

**Chapter Representative's Report: Chapter Representative Al  
Mitchell reported on the Board of Directors meeting held  
November 19. Next year's convention will be held in September in  
conjunction with the Michigan Society of Enrolled Agents near  
Ann Arbor. OSSEA's relationship with IRS for continuing  
education has been extended through June 30, 2012. New**

**regulations will take effect at that time. EAGCC may have to become the continuing education provider and pay a \$75 fee to the IRS and meet IRS standards in order to provide continuing education credit. Al recommended that all members review the IRS guidelines and provide comments to him for the next board meeting. Al pointed out that beginning in January 2012 the OSSEA journal will be sent by email, and that members should make sure Bev Buttermore has their email addresses to continue to receive the journal.**

**Old Business: New (old) officers of OSSEA were installed in an abbreviated ceremony conducted by Fred Davison. Fred stated that Quickfinders have been ordered and some have already been delivered. Fred has resigned as Quickfinder chair after this year, and has the thanks of the Chapter. It was mentioned that all members should renew their PTIN by December 31 and that EAs with social security numbers ending in 7,8 and 9 need to renew their credential with the IRS.**

**New Business: A new Quickfinder chair will be needed for next year. A nominating committee is needed for the 2013 officer election.**
