

EAGCC October Meeting Minutes

October 13, 2009

The meeting was called to order by President Linda Fritsch at 6:30 PM with 18 members present.

Secretary's Report: The minutes of the previous meeting were accepted as submitted via e-mail.

Treasurer's Report: Treasurer Don Forney reported the balance in the treasury of \$3,857.10.

Chapter Representative's Report: Chapter Representative Linda Fritsch reported on the State Convention, which was held in Columbus this year. Members liked the dual-track coursework. The Cincinnati team of Jim and Miriam won at "Ethics Jeopardy." Next year's convention will be held at Maumee State Park, and at Heuston Woods the following year. Fall Update will be held November 13.

Old Business: Bobbie Wavra-Mouch is waiting to hear from the cable company on a date to tape the community outreach show. The show will be a question-and-answer format geared toward individual taxpayers and self-employed, not business entities. She anticipates a date for taping the show sometime in November and hopes to have it aired in January and April.

New Business: Fred Davison discussed Quickfinder orders. Order forms were sent to members via e-mail, with payment due by the November chapter meeting or the day after if by mail, with delivery at the January meeting. Fred reported that prices are lower than last year. Members attending seven or more meetings will get a free Quickfinder courtesy of the chapter. Al Mitchell raised the question that if one wanted the Deluxe edition, would they get \$38 credit if eligible for a free standard edition. Membership decided to extend this credit. Members must pay the \$24 difference when placing their order.

Good of the Order: The January meeting will not take place at the Ramada Inn as it is now closed. The meeting will be held January 5, which is the first Tuesday of January. Don Forney has contacted two other venues. Membership decided to try to keep the cost under \$400.

Diana Thompson will serve on a panel with the IRS Compliance Forum.

Elections will take place at the November meeting for installation at the January meeting.
